| <p>This half term our talk 4 writing story will be Six Dinner Sid written and illustrated by Inga Moore. This is a lovely story about a cat called Sid. Sid is addicted to having six meals a day and glories in this lifestyle. Manipulative, persuasive and a charmer he has wrapped everybody round his little paw - each owner believes that Sid belongs to them only . . . until the day he is found out! As a class we will be creating a story map, once we know the story well the pupils will be having a go at changing the story to make our own versions.</p>  <p>We will be continuing with our Little wandle phonics following on from last year's successes. The pupils in class will be working within a variety of different levels according to their prior learning and understanding.</p>  <p>During our english sessions the pupils will be writing/typing to inform (Communicating information from ourselves to others) We will be teaching the pupils how to give factual relevant and clear information to others. As always we will be encouraging the children to use punctuation and in their work. Full stops, capital letters etc.</p> | <p>In maths this half term we will be continuing to work on our maths mastery curriculum alongside our mastering number project. Again children have been assessed by their previous teachers and will be working within the standards that have been identified by these assessments. Will be having lots of fun maths activities for the children to take part in as part of our continuous provision.</p> <p>In class maths we will be looking at measures-Length.</p> | <p>This half term our PSHE topic is healthy lifestyles and self awareness As in previous years, children will check in twice a day using zones of regulation. We will be taking a closer look at the feelings that we all feel and identifying how they are feeling and from a visual cue how their friends are feeling. As a class we will be learning to communicate our feelings and beginning to describe why we think we feel the way we do at that given time. As part of this we will also be introducing the children to Zippy and exploring significant life events.</p> |
