 <p>This half term story is Nick Sharratt's Shark in the Park. It is a delightful read that will have us all giggling with anticipation. This is an interactive experience, perfectly crafted to engage all readers. This book is perfect for sparking conversation about perception and observation. It's a fantastic tool for encouraging early literacy skills, from predicting what comes next to understanding cause and effect.</p>  <p>In phonics, we will continue following the <i>Little Wandle</i> progression. The students will work on learning the next grapheme-phoneme correspondences (GPCs) to further develop their reading and writing skills. Where appropriate, some children will also use a whole word approach to reinforce their learning and maximize their progress.</p> <p>Alongside all this we will gently introduce the exciting concept of writing to persuade, carefully tailored for our children Through playful activities like choosing favourite toys, requesting specific snacks, or "convincing" a puppet, children will explore how our words and gestures can encourage others to agree with us or choose something, fostering early communication skills, developing expressive language, and understanding the power of their voice in a fun and supportive environment.</p>	<p>This half term, we will continue working on our Maths Mastery curriculum, alongside the <i>Mastering Number</i> project. The children will enjoy a range of fun and engaging maths activities as part of our continuous provision, allowing them to explore and develop their mathematical skills in a hands-on way.</p> <p>In class, we will focus on learning about shape space and measure. <p>This half term, our adventure will take us to the Beach (metaphorically), exploring its fascinating journey through past and present, and discovering diverse beaches from around the world., Through sensory play with sand and water, exploring various shells and pebbles, and engaging with colourful visuals, children will discover the key features of beaches and the coast, building their understanding of relevant vocabulary (e.g., sand, waves, shells, tide, rock pool) and fostering an appreciation for these dynamic natural environments.</p>	<p>This half term, our learning will blossom as we explore Plants and the delightful Seasonal changes of Summer, Through hands-on sensory exploration in our outdoor spaces, observations of local flora, and simple planting activities, pupils will discover the characteristics of summer plants, observe their growth, and understand how the warmer weather impacts nature, fostering an early connection with the natural world and seasonal cycles.</p>	<p>This half term we will immerse ourselves in the vibrant world of artist Dale Chihuly, exploring his spectacular 3D glass sculptures through multi-sensory experiences and adapted art activities. Children will engage with both rigid and malleable materials, such as building blocks, playdough, pipe cleaners, and fabric scraps, to create their own 3D sculptures, fostering an understanding of different textures and forms while developing fine motor skills and imaginative expression.</p>
