

## Around the World

### Literacy/Reading

Listening to, discussing and expressing views on a range of fiction and non-fiction at a level beyond that at which they can read independently. Using prefixes and suffixes correctly; extending sentences using different connectives and adjectives; apply a greater range of punctuation and understanding different types of sentences.

Fictional and non-fictional texts/videos from around the world and traditional tales from across the globe.

Phonics at an appropriate level for each child; Nessy Phonics; daily handwriting practice; high frequency word practice; daily reading comprehension; daily reading with an adult; phonics sound of the week.

### Mathematics

Consolidation of various addition and subtraction strategies to progress from concrete to pictorial to abstract, focusing on mastery.

Number: multiplication and division. Recall and use multiplication and division facts for the 2, 5 and 10 multiplication tables. Calculate mathematical statements for multiplication and division within the multiplication tables and write them using the multiplication ( $\times$ ), division ( $\div$ ) and equals (=) signs.

Measures: length and time.

### Life Skills

Adapting to change and referring to clocks meaningfully.

Recognising and understanding different emotions and strategies to support self-regulation.

Personal hygiene and staying safe.

Days of the week and months of the year.

Stating and writing full name, address and postcode.

Basic IT skills, Nessy phonics.

Preparing and making meals from countries around the world.

### Science

Seasonal changes and weather.

Climates around the world.

Healthy eating and healthy lifestyles.
