

# The Seaside

## Literacy/Reading

Listening to, discussing and expressing views on a range of fiction and non-fiction at a level beyond that at which they can read independently. Retelling and innovating stories; editing and up-leveilling work; apply a greater range of connectives and vocabulary (use of synonyms).

Talk for Writing key focus texts.

Fictional and non-fictional texts/videos about the seaside.

Phonics at an appropriate level for each child; Nessy Phonics; daily handwriting practice; high frequency word practice; daily reading comprehension; daily reading with an adult; phonics sound of the week.

## Mathematics

Consolidation of various addition and subtraction strategies to progress from concrete to pictorial to abstract, focusing on mastery.

Money: finding the total, differences and solving two-step problems.

Geometry: position and direction. Describing movement and turns.

Measurement: Time. Writing and comparing time. Analogue and digital time.

## Life Skills

Following steps and recipes to make meals independently.

Using a range of strategies to support self-regulation.

Social scenario role play and activities to support social skills.

Activities to support transition to secondary school.

Days of the week and months of the year.

Using technology safely.

Exploring and recognising common uses of IT, Nessy phonics.
