Using the text as inspiration, Galaxy will be considering the ways in which illustrations can deepen and enrich the meaning of a text and enhance the reader experience. The children will continue to work on our multiplication and division strategies. We will also be working on our understanding of positional and directional language. Alongside this those children working within the year 1 curriculum will continue to work on addition and subtraction within 20 and place value within 50</p>	<p>Many times a day every child is encouraged to consider their own and the feelings of others, reflecting on our emotions and state of regulation supported by zones of regulation.</p> <p>This half term we will be focusing on Relationships Education. In Year 6 we continue to explore the ideas of changing and growing, building on previous learning. We will be revisiting the emotional and physical changes experienced as we grow, looking again at puberty, friendships and relationships with our peers.</p>

	<p>This half term is all about life cycles! The children will be learning life cycles in plants and animals including humans. This links in to our PSHE topic where we will be looking at relationships and how our bodies change as we grow.</p>	<p>In art this half term we are looking at the skill collage. The children will be given many opportunities to create their own work from a vast array of materials and resources (Fabric, paper, sticks, stones, feathers, leaves, sand, soil). The children will be encouraged to express themselves in their work and show us that they are able to create work from a blank canvas and also from a painted background. The artist that we will be looking at and taking inspiration from will be Kandinsky, we will be looking at the famous circle picture and trying to recreate it in a variety of different ways.</p>
